## PLYMOUTH TOWN BOARD BUDGET MEETING SEPTEMBER 15, 2020

Mrs. Alger brought the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Mrs. Alger informed everyone that the tax cap was 1.5% and not 2% as she had previously stated.

Mrs. Alger asked everyone to turn to page 16 of the proposed 2021 Budget. She pointed out that Line A9720.6 Statutory Bonds (Principal) and Line A9720.7 Statutory Bonds (Interest) were new additions to the budget because of the recent purchase of an excavator. Also, Line A2530 (under Revenues) for Hunting Licenses was added.

Mr. Oakley explained the raise in wages for the Highway crew. Mr. Oakley also asked the Board for a \$3,000.00 raise. He listed the reasons that he felt he was deserving of this raise including the fact that he has

not had a raise since the first year he was elected. Discussion followed. The Board decided that they would make a final decision at the next budget meeting.

Mrs. Alger asked Mrs. Brown to inquire about the Fire Department's budget.

The Board signed the three resolutions that had been passed on September 14, 2020.

Mr. Kreiner asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Williams seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the motion was passed with five yeses and no nos. The meeting was adjourned at 7:10pm.
