

# **PLYMOUTH TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Supervisor led in the pledge to the Flag.  
She introduced Ms. Burns and Mr. Shapiro from the District Court System. They discussed the Records Room and the Security System in the building. They said generally there are no recordings in the Court room unless approved by the Judge. The Board members were concerned about the security for the Town Hall. Ms. Burns and Mr. Shapiro encouraged the Board to approve applying for a grant to update the Security System. They also said the Judge has to have access to the Court records.

Ms. Murray revealed to everyone that the State Audit that was done is available for anyone to read on the OSC website. The Town has 90 days to respond. No monetary recourse is planned.

Ms. Fairbanks expressed concern about the loss of sales tax money due to the closing of the Dollar Store in Plymouth. Ms. Murray said that the Towns in the County share sales tax so the impact won't be as severe as it was feared.

The issue of a the Junk Storage law was brought up. Mr. Wightman suggested that the law be presented to the Town attorney for verifications and revisions.

Mr. Wightman stated that the second internet jack in the Town Clerk's office is not working. It is needed to get the Deputy Clerk's computer working. Ms. Murray said she would get someone to come and look at it.

Mr. Wightman said that his name and profile picture had been used by someone to threaten and say vulgar things to people. He emphasized that it was not him. Several others reported that they had been victimized by this as well.

Mr. Manwarren made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Fairbanks seconded the motion. The Board was polled and the motion was carried with five yeses and no nos. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00pm.
