A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW TOWN BOARD MEMBERS ACCOUNT ACCESS TO ALL TOWN SECURITY MONITORING ACCOUNTS

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Plymouth recognizes the importance of ensuring proper oversight and transparency in the management of the Town's security monitoring systems; and

WHEREAS, providing Town Board Members with access to all Town security monitoring accounts will enhance oversight and ensure the proper functioning and management of these systems; and

WHEREAS, this measure aligns with the Town Board's commitment to accountability and effective governance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Plymouth as follows:

1. Authorization of Account Access

The Town Board authorizes account access to all Town security monitoring accounts for all Town Board Members.

2. Implementation

The Town Supervisor is hereby directed to coordinate with the Town's security monitoring service providers to facilitate account access for Town Board Members, ensuring appropriate security protocols are followed.

3. Scope of Access

Account access shall include the ability to view system activity, monitor security footage, and review alerts but shall not permit unauthorized changes to account settings or operational configurations.

4. Confidentiality

Town Board Members shall maintain the confidentiality of all information accessed and adhere to any applicable policies or regulations regarding the handling of sensitive information.

5. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this resolution shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

6. Effective Date

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
